Faculty Speakers and Information

Dr. Raghunath Puttaiah, a public health dentist, was awarded the first Johnson & Johnson Medical Inc. Post-Doctoral Fellowship in Infectious Disease Control in Dentistry in 1993 and completed the Fellowship in 1996. He joined the Texas A&M University Baylor College of Dentistry as a tenure-track faculty and is currently a Professor with Tenure in Diagnostic Sciences at the same institution. Dr. Puttaiah has conducted multiple research studies funded by the NIH/NIDCR SBIR Program as well as the Dental Industry in the USA, Europe and Asia. He has published numerous peer-review research papers, reviewer for journal of repute, and has served as a consultant for over 25 dental industries worldwide. Dr. Puttaiah has provided CDE Programs in over 60 meetings worldwide. He crafted the Infection Control & Occupational Safety Standards for India in 1987 through the Dental Council of India. Currently, through the International College of Dentists, he is helping build capacity in Dental Infection Control & Safety in various regions of need.



Dr. Mahesh Verma is an Indian prosthodontist and the Director and Principal of Maulana Azad Institute of Dental Sciences.

For his contributions to the fields of medicine He was awarded the Padma Shri in 2014 by the Govt. of India. He is also the recipient of the State Award from the Govt. of Delhi, the B.C. Roy Award, Rotary Vashishat Sewa Samman, P.N Behl Foundation Award, B.C. Shroff Oration Awards and multiple commendations. He is a Fellow of the International College of Dentists, Pierre Fauchard Academy, Academy of Implant Dentistry, Indian Medical Sciences Academy, the Royal College of Surgeons of England and Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. Dr. Verma is the President of the International College of Dentists for India and Sri Lanka Chapter, Vice President of the Dental Council of India, the Registrar of Delhi Dental Council, Advisor to the Armed Forces Dental Services and an international advisor to the Royal College of Physicians and Surgeons of Glasgow. He is well published and serves on multiple editorial boards of internationally recognized peer review journals. He is an avid proponent of Dental Infection Control & Occupational Safety and integration of Dental Safety into the Dental Curriculum.



Dr. Prashanth Konatham Haribabu is faculty in the Department of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery, Univ. of Detroit Mercy-School of Dentistry, USA. He completed his BDS and MDS in India. Dr. Haribabu completed advanced training in Orofacial Pain & Temporo-Mandibular Joint Disorders at Rutgers School of Dental Medicine in the United States of America. He furthered his training and graduated with a fellowship in Managing Medically Complex Patients and Infectious Disease dentistry in 2013 at Rutgers School of Dental Medicine. His research focus is on the Pain & Sensory alterations in the Head & Neck Cancer patients. He served as a Program Co-Director in training Diagnostic Sciences Fellows. Currently Dr. Haribabu is involved in training dental students, interns and OMFS residents in the oral surgical management of medically complex patients. He has several publications pertaining to oral surgery (implant dentistry) and orofacial pain in reputed internationally acclaimed peer reviewed journals. Dr. Haribabu has been an invited guest speaker at various institutions in India on topics including Oral surgery & Orofacial Pain management. He is one of the reviewers to the Journal-Quintessence International and the International Journal of Clinical Implant Dentistry. His current focus is on training dental practitioners and faculty in Dental Infection Control & Occupational Safety.



Dr. Carl Misch, International College of Dentists and the International Congress of Oral Implantologists (ICOI) have established a permanent legacy endowment to memorialize and continue the contributions of Dr. Carl Misch (USA) to the advancement of dental knowledge and oral health. Dr. Misch is an ICD Fellow and is the Co-Chairman of ICOI. Dr. Mish is a world renown innovator, author and educator in the field of oral implantology education and development. More than 4,000 dentists are graduates of the Misch Institute, while countless others worldwide were educated in implantology through his books and lectures. His clinical career was unexpectedly ended by ill health. In 2014, Dr. Misch received the ADA Distinguished Service Award, the highest award for professional achievement of The American Dental Association.
