

ICD Global Visionary Fund Grant Application: Henry Schein Cares Program

The **ICD Global Visionary Fund** was created to improve the oral health of the public and enhance the profession of dentistry. It does this by supporting initiatives in humanitarian dental care projects and continuing dental education.

Presently applications are being considered for the provision of dental materials and equipment for use in charitable dental treatment projects. Collaborating with our strategic partner, **Henry Schein Cares**, our International Projects Approval Board will review applications for grants of equipment and materials, which will then be delivered to the applicant by Henry Schein for use in charitable projects that qualify.

Projects demonstrating the possibility of achieving a sustainable improvement in oral health will be favored, and projects should involve a member(s) of the International College of Dentists. Additionally, applicants must provide a specific list of the requested materials and explain how they will be used effectively.

Grant awards are preferred to be valued at a maximum of \$5,000. Applications should be submitted at least 2 months in advance of when supplies are needed.

APPLICATION – Please provide the following information:

- The Title of the project to be funded
- Details of the Applicant (name, title, contact information, position within the project)
- Brief Summary of the project (abstract)
- Description of the project:
 - Location, date and timeframe of the project.
 - What evidence is there for of the need for this project?
 - What outcomes are projected for the project?
 - Operational plan for the project: Describe methods to be used, nature of services to be provided, and the monitoring and reporting of results. Provide contact information of the person responsible on site for the project and for the security of the requested materials. Provide names of other dentists participating.
 - What are your plans to get the materials or equipment to the project site?
 - How will customs charges be managed (if any)?
 - Who will own any remaining materials or equipment at the conclusion of the project?
- Are other projects of this nature being successfully done by you or others?
- How will the ICD Global Visionary Fund and Henry Schein Cares receive public recognition for participating?

REQUIREMENT – A follow-up report must be submitted to the ICD College Office (office@icd.org) upon conclusion of the project. The report should include all project outcomes (i.e. # of persons helped, taught, treated, etc.), photographs, videos and/or any other content collected during the project. This information is important to the grant process and helps to ensure granted supplies are being utilized accordingly.
