

ICD Global Visionary Fund – Henry Schein Cares Foundation Grant Application

The **ICD Global Visionary Fund** was created to improve the oral health of the public and enhance the profession of dentistry. It does this by supporting initiatives in humanitarian dental care projects and continuing dental education.

Applications are being considered for the provision of dental materials and equipment for use in charitable dental treatment and prevention projects. Collaborating with our strategic partner, **Henry Schein Cares**, our International Projects Approval Board will review applications for grants of equipment and materials, which will then, upon approval, be delivered to the applicant by Henry Schein for use in charitable projects that qualify. Projects demonstrating the possibility of achieving a **sustainable improvement in oral health and good cost/health improvement ratio** will be favored. Projects should involve a member(s) of the International College of Dentists. Applicants must also provide a specific list of the requested materials and explain how they will be used effectively.

Application Processing

- Total Fair Market Value of requested supplies **must not exceed \$5,000 US**
- Applications must be submitted **at least 90 days prior** to the date the supplies are needed
- Applications will be reviewed on rolling basis, but the review process timeframe is **subject to change**

Required Application Information – Please address the following information in your application:

- **Project Title**
- **Details of the Applicant** (name, title, contact information, position within the project)
- **Brief Project Summary** (abstract)
- **Description of the Project:**
 - Location, date and timeframe of the project
 - Evidence, pre-assessment measure, demonstrating the need for this project
 - Projected outcomes
 - Operational plan for the project: Describe methods to be used, nature of services to be provided, and the monitoring and reporting of results. Provide contact information of the person responsible on site and for the security of the requested materials. Provide names of other dentists, volunteers and/or Fellows participating.
 - Operational plan for getting materials or equipment to the project site
 - How will customs charges be managed (if any)?
 - Who will own any remaining materials or equipment at conclusion of the project?
- **Are other projects of this nature being successfully done by you or others?**
- **How will the ICD Global Visionary Fund and Henry Schein Cares receive public recognition for participating?**
- **Estimated fair market value of the supplies being requested: \$ _____ US**
- **A follow-up report must be submitted to the ICD College Office (office@icd.org) upon conclusion of the project.** The report should include project outcomes (# of persons serviced), photographs, videos and/or any other content collected during the project. This information is important to the grant process and helps to ensure granted supplies are being utilized appropriately.
