The final figure is yet to be determined, and will depend, in part, upon successful fundraising, but the Board is using a minimum figure of US \$15,000 as a starting point. Section I recognizes its position as the largest and oldest Section in the College, and it hopes that this gift inspires its Fellow Sections to donate to this Gala celebration to whatever degree is possible,” said Past College President and Past Section I President, Dr. Joe Kenneally.
