

ICD Egypt Gives Back to the Community

ICD Fellows of newly-chartered [ICD Region 29](#) (Egypt, Sudan) helped carry out a dental mission in an Egyptian village on May 6, in collaboration with faculty members of Alexandria University, the Dental Student Scientific Association (DSSA-Alexandria), and the Arabic Union of Working Women.

The voluntary team consisted of dentists, physicians, students and paediatricians that provided dental and medical services to over 170 dental patients and 400

about 68 kilometers from Alexandria. Twenty-five dentists and students together provided dental treatment, dental education and supplies to those in need. With the use of a mobile dental truck, support from the Alexandria University Faculty of Dentistry, and supplies from Fellows of ICD Region 29, the village benefitted enormously from this much needed care.
